



## FIELD BOOT INSTRUCTIONS AND TIPS



If your dog is not accustomed to wearing boots, it is important to be patient and get the boot on correctly. This process will become easier each time it is done.

Slip the boot on with the sole down and use the rear tongue of the boot to pull the boot into place. After attaching the vertical Velcro strip, attach the rear tongue on the *outside* of the boot. Then wrap and tighten the two Velcro straps around the leg.



If this is the first time for your dog to wear boots it will take a short time for them to get accustomed to the feel of the boot. (Try not to laugh during this early adjustment.) Having a walk or a fun activity ready for the dog will shorten the adjustment period.

Do not machine wash the boots. Hand wash only.
